igh school is its own kind of challenge. It is good to know that in this place there are folks who have their eyes and ears and arms around this fragile and complex group of young people – young people from all sorts of backgrounds and cultures, cultivated on a farm, a place where things are grown organically...students and vegetables alike.

There are days when I am not on top of my parenting game. In those moments I am unbelievably grateful for the entire Common Ground team. See, I appreciate the rigorous academic program, and all the extracurricular activities presented. But what I am most blown away by is the willingness of teachers and staff to go the distance with a student when issues arise that are outside or adjacent to academic pursuit.

I experienced this first-hand when my son was a freshman. Struggling with his academic load and the newness of high school, his teachers Ms. Frasier, Mr. Greene, and Ms. Miriam Sheffield met with us to craft a plan on how to turn his failure into success. They never wavered in their commitment and concern for his well-being. Even when I. as the mother was worn thin.


I have seen this team pull together to resolve issues not with just my children, but with several students. I've seen restorative justice in action. I've seen teachers go to bat for students.

I love the way the cafeteria folks interact and talk to and engage students. This is why my children are here. This is why I do what I can, when I can, for this place.

In 2015, Common Ground's 4-year graduation rate was 100% – more than 10 points above the state average. We believe that every student can succeed in high school, and meet high standards, if given the supports they deserve.

Planting Seeds

I see this again and again at Common Ground: we challenge students to get out of their comfort zones and experience new things. It might be hiking in the woods, eating fresh kale from our garden, or touching a live goat. I love seeing the look of sheer delight on students' faces as they make new discoveries!

As students try something new and have a positive experience, they build self-confidence and broaden their worldview. When these positive experiences happen outdoors, it helps them develop a love and respect for nature. Rayna and many others like her demonstrate how we are shaping a community that values green spaces and gardens, and empowering the next generation of environmental stewards

In 2015, Common Ground welcomed more than 5,500 young people from grades K-8, and 900 of their teachers, to Common Ground for educational field trips. When we followed up to ask teachers about their experiences, 100% of those who responded said the experience was developmentally appropriate, and 100% said our educators were positive and welcoming.



We know that all our students can grow into successful college students and powerful environmental leaders. Last year, 100% of our seniors successfully defended portfolios showing their growth as leaders. Ninety percent of these grads were accepted into college, and 86% enrolled in college or training programs in the year after graduation.

Growing Leaders

We asked recent grads to tell us what they were doing last year, and want you to know they continue their growth as leaders:

Malik Joyner has been "balancing college and work planting trees with the Urban Resources Initiative, finding time to complete my studies while doing work that makes our community stronger."

Dante Petti spent the summer after freshman year "in China, conducting interviews about the migrant labor issue." He got back in time "to protest the North Dakota access pipeline."

Janet Sakouvogui struggled to find her place as one of the only students of color on a small college

campus – facing overt racism and an unresponsive college administration. She ultimately decided to transfer to another college, but built a student club to advocate for change before doing so. "I realized my college was not built for students of color. I started thinking about other students of color, and I created a club called the ROOTs, which is for anybody who calls themselves a student of color. After creating this group with three other students, I realized that I was a strong person. I realized that there isn't anybody in this

world that can break me down and make me hate my skin color."

Cultivating Community



Conte West Hills Magnet School faculty share their experiences with their school garden (established 2013) and schoolyard habitat (established 2016):

I watched this amazing team take our vision and make it reality.

There were parents, kids, teachers – just an awesome experience of working together.

Our students are so excited. They're asking about when they can go out all the time. Our youngest run out and notice that the radish seeds have come out, the buds on our flowers, and enjoy the wonder of finding insects."

New Haven public schools to date have created gardens and/or schoolyard habitats with help from Common Ground

To date, Common Ground has helped 16 New Haven public schools create gardens and schoolyard habitats – and turn these growing spaces into outdoor classrooms. Research by our partners at Audubon Connecticut demonstrates that participating teachers go outside to teach a lesson 57% more often.

The timber used in Common Ground's new building offsets the annual emissions of 107 cars, making the building carbon neutral in its first decade of operation. The collective impact of geothermal power, natural lighting, computer-controlled heating and cooling systems, and other energy efficiency measures are projected to reduce overall annual energy use by 60%.

Taking Root

t has been more than 6 months since we finished construction, yet walking onto our campus each morning I am still amazed at how the addition of our new building has completely transformed our site. I still think back fondly to the raw beauty of the Common Ground site of 9 years ago when I first came to work here. While at times I miss those rough edges, I also remember a constant fight

to keep invasive plant species from overwhelming the landscape; the floods raging across our campus with each significant rain event; and the anxiety we suffered when field trip buses

had to park on Springside Avenue to let kids onto our site.

Although very different from 9 years ago, I am still struck by the beauty of our site each day as I arrive at work. But now, new design features welcome visitors and enhance our site's functionality. For example, the walking path from the parking lot compels visitors to take in the bounty of our farm as they approach our campus. A beautifully landscaped rain garden, designed to capture, cleanse and infiltrate rainwater flowing across our site, greets visitors as they walk up to the new building. To the right, where once there was only a drainage ditch and a tangled mass of vegetation, a common grassy area now provides a welcoming gathering space. Nearby is the Javier Martinez

wetland, chock full of frogs and turtles...and often young program participants too!

And these changes have impacted programs deeply and broadly! Our programs are richer, safer, and have more beautiful and more functional space to operate in. Your support made this possible.
