### **Cucurbits (Cucumber, Squash, Melons, etc...) Small Single Plastic Pots \$2.00**

Crop	Type	Notes
Cucumbers	Slicing	<b>Marketmore</b> is a regular green cucumber. Sweet, crisp, nearly seedless, great for slicing.
	Specialty	<b>Lemon</b> is a round, yellow cuke with a mild lemony taste. Matures in early fall (September).
	Pickling	<b>Max Pack</b> has huge yields of very uniform and attractive picklers borne on vigorous vines. Resists bitterness under stress. High resistance other diseases.
<b>Cucamelons OR Sour Gherkins</b>		Look like miniature watermelons and taste like cucumbers with citrus and tangy overtones. Great for snacking.
Summer Squash	Yellow	<b>Golden Glory</b> -Bright Yellow Squash. High-yielding plants. Excellent disease resistance keeps the plant productive over a long season.
	Green (aka Zucchini!)	<b>Dunja</b> - F1, Dark Green Zucchini. High yielder of dark-green, straight zucchinis.
Melons	Watermelon	<b>Sugar Baby</b> is dark green and has seeds. It will set 3-6 fruits and vine 6 feet. Deep green rind, red flesh. 10" round fruits. Separate seedlings and plant 2 feet apart
	Cantaloupe	<b>Sugar Cube</b> has an intensely sweet flavor. Very uniform, 2-2 1/2 lb. fruits (just a bit bigger than a softball) with deep-orange, aromatic flesh, perfect for single servings. Strong disease resistance. Well-suited for Northern and Southern growers.

### **Eggplants Small Single Plastic Pots \$2.00**

Variety	Color	Notes	Type
<b>Ping Tung Long</b>	Dark purple	HEIRLOOM. Asian eggplant, very prolific and early. Long and slender fruits hold on plants well.	Asian
<b>Galine</b>	Dark Purple	Very glossy, uniform, black fruits are 6-7" long by 3-4" in diameter. Strong plants produce early, firm fruits.	Italian

### **HOT Peppers Small Single Plastic Pots \$2.00**

Variety	Color	Notes
<b>Hungarian Hot Wax</b>	Yellow to red	5 1/2" x 1 1/2" smooth, waxy fruits tapering to a point. Easy to stuff and to peel after roasting; thick-fleshed for frying. Its sunset-ripening peppers change from yellow to orange to red, and make the prettiest pickled peppers.
<b>Bastan, Ancho Poblano</b>	Green to red	Sweet, thick flesh. 4 1/2-5" x 3" fruits are moderately hot and traditionally used for chile rellenos. Big sturdy plant holds abundant, uniform, heavy fruit well off the ground.
<b>Jalapeño, Jedi</b>	Green to red	High yielding jalapeño. A classic Mexican hot pepper...great for roasting, salsas and pickling.
<b>Red Rocket</b>	Green to red	An early cayenne type chile fruits. Dries quickly to a bright crimson red. Dried fruits have tender flesh which is nice and soft when cooked. Early, high yielding and widely adapted.
<b>Habanero</b>	Green to orange	The habanero is 100 times hotter than the jalapeno. It's a key ingredient in Jamaican "jerk" sauces.

Variety	Color	Notes
<b>Stocky Red, Italian Roasting</b>	Ripe when red	Outstanding variety with juicy, sweet fruits; Attractive, smooth skinned fruits with thick walls. Tall plants with upright habit are covered in fruit. For Roasting!

Variety	Color	Notes	Type
<b>Cherokee Purple</b>	Black	HEIRLOOM. Old Cherokee Indian heirloom, pre-1890 variety; beautiful deep dusky purple-pink color, superb sweet flavor, and very large sized fruit. Try this one for real old-time tomato flavor.	Heirloom
<b>Rose</b>	Deep pink	Rivals <b>Brandywine</b> for taste. Smoother than Brandywine, Rose is every bit as meaty and flavorful. Fruits weigh 10+ oz. Good yielding heirloom.	Heirloom
<b>Striped German</b>	Bicolor red/yellow fruit	The flat, medium to large, variably ribbed-shoulder tomatoes are shaded yellow and red. The marbled interior looks beautiful sliced. Complex, fruity flavor and smooth texture.	Heirloom
<b>Green Zebra</b>	Green and yellow	Beautiful chartreuse with deep lime-green stripes. Flesh is bright green and very rich tasting, sweet with a sharp bite to it. Yield is excellent.	Heirloom
<b>Sungold</b>	Orange	Very sweet, fruity/tropical flavor. Will make hundreds of medium sized cherry tomatoes.	Cherry

## Herb Sets of 3 \$6.00

Variety	Notes
<b>Herbs</b>	<b>German Winter Thyme</b> is a low-growing plant with fragrant leaves. This herb goes well with just about everything.
	<b>Chives</b> are like a perennial scallion.
	<b>Parsley</b> Dark green, flat leaves with strong stems. Use leaves for garnishes, salads, and cooking.
	<b>Dill</b>
	<b>Oregano</b> Strong oregano aroma and flavor; great for pizza and Italian cooking. Characteristic dark green leaves with white flowers.
	<b>Sorrel</b> has a sour, lemon flavor. The bright green, oblong leaves and long stems have a growth habit similar to spinach. Use as an herb and/or vegetable, this perennial can be harvested over a long season.
	<b>Sage</b> A staple of the herb garden. Dusty, green leaves are used in dressing, sauces, salted herbs, sausage, and tea. Make a good base for dried floral wreaths. Also known as garden sage. Perennial in Zones 4-8. Edible Flowers: Edible, lovely, small lavender flowers appear in early summer with a mild and sage-like flavor. Flower spikes can be battered and fried, cooked in rice, egg, or cheese dishes, or used to garnish salads and pizza.

Seedling	Notes
<b>Bok Choi, Black Summer</b>	A smaller classic Chinese stir fry green. Plant 6" apart and harvest when heads are big and dense.
<b>Broccoli, De Cicco</b>	Harvest in spring through early summer snapping smaller side shoots for several weeks.
<b>Cabbage, Green</b>	<b>Primo Vantage</b> Heads avg. 4-4 1/2 lb., have a very short core, and are very juicy, tender, and sweet. Holds well in the field. Primo Vantage has performed well in the East, West, and desert Southwest.
<b>Cabbage, Red</b>	<b>Ruby Perfection</b> The #1 mid-late red cabbage. The heads are medium-sized and dense with a uniform high-round shape and good wrapper leaves. Good field-holding ability. Matures just in time for late summer crops or fall harvest for medium-term storage. Resistant to thrips
<b>Collards, Champion</b>	Rich, dark-green color with long, broad, wavy, tender leaves.
<b>Herbs</b>	We have mixed and single variety packs. Italian Basil, Purple Basil, Lemon Basil, Chives, Parsley, Sage, Cilantro, Dill and Thyme!
<b>Kale</b>	<b>Red Russian</b> - Stems are purple; leaves are gray-green, purple-veined, flat, noncurled, and tooth-edged. The plants mature medium-tall and leaves are tender compared to other kales.
	<b>Lacinato, "dino"</b> - Extra-dark green, noncurled but blistered (savoyed).
	<b>Darkibor</b> - Curly leafed Kale.
<b>Lettuce Mix</b>	Plant tightly for cut lettuce or separate each seedling to make a lettuce head. Space 6 to 8 inches for head lettuce, 1 to 2 inches for cut lettuce.
<b>Napa Cabbage</b>	Chinese cabbage - perfect for stir fry and kimchee! Large, upright growth.
<b>Scallions</b>	Bunching onion
<b>Sorrel</b>	Sorrel has a sour, lemon flavor. The bright green, oblong leaves and long stems have a growth habit similar to spinach. Use as an herb and/or vegetable, this perennial can be harvested over a long season.
<b>Sugar Snap Peas</b>	Trellis up to 3 feet. Fruit should start to set in mid June
<b>Swiss Chard</b>	Chard is a summer spinach with rainbow stems. Pick large outer leaves for continuous harvest.
<b>String Beans</b>	Bush beans don't climb! Plant 3" apart and pick continuously for extended harvest.

<b>Sunflower, Branching</b>	Mixed Packs with Autumn Beauty
<b>Zinnia</b>	<b>OK Formula Mix</b> Bright colors, excellent vase life, and low susceptibility to powdery mildew.
<b>Cosmos</b>	<b>Sensation Mix</b> Single flowers, 3-4" across, in lavender, pink, magenta and white.
<b>Strawflower</b>	Tall, well-branched plants. <b>Sultane Mix</b> includes white, bright pink, silvery rose, salmon, yellow, orange, and copper-red colors for fresh-cut or dried flowers.
<b>Statice</b>	Flower clusters are produced on strong stems. <b>Seeker Mix</b> is more uniform and has a better color range (blue, pastel blue, purple, white, and shades of yellow and rose).
<b>Snap Dragons</b>	<b>Rocket Mix</b> Tolerates light frost. Mix includes rose shades, cherry, pink, orchid, red, golden, lemon, and white.
<b>Marigold</b>	<b>Durango Outback</b> Extra-large blooms with outstanding uniformity. Highly branching plants. A good choice for packs, pots, and garden planting. Bloom size is 2-2 1/2". Attracts beneficial insects such as hoverflies. Also known as French marigold. <b>Edible Flowers:</b> Use the flowers to dress up salads and desserts or cooked in egg or rice dishes. Flavor is floral with hints of citrus and spice, and slightly bitter. Remove the petals from the flower base before consuming as the base can be quite bitter.
<b>Gomphrena</b>	Productive accent flower for fresh and dried arrangements. Globe shaped blooms in shades of purple, pink, and white.
<b>Celosia</b>	<b>Pampus Plume</b> Masses of soft, feathery, 2-6" long plumes in scarlet, orange, bright yellow, pink, cream. Also known as cockscomb, Prince of Wales feather, and prince feather.
<b>Calendula</b>	Clear bright-orange blooms are reminiscent of gerberas. High resin content for medicinal use. 2 - 3 1/2" blooms. Also known as pot marigold, common marigold, and Scotch marigold.
